

An Increase in HPD Patrols in Royal Shores

As a result of some criminal activity in our neighborhood, the Board has, again, been in contact with HPD in Kingwood, the liaison for the COH Mayor's Office, and our COH city councilman. In response to our emails and contacts, Lt. Glenn Fuhs of the HPD Kingwood Division has committed to "assigning additional patrols in the neighborhood and the park for all three shifts." Lt Fuhs further states that HPD will "also let our radar units know the speeding problem still exists and to continue their enforcement efforts." In addition, the HPD Bicycle Detail will patrol our community on a periodic basis.

We hope that the increased presence of HPD patrol officers will serve notice to anyone bent on criminal activity that Royal Shores is better protected than ever.
